## ROUND VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

<b>TOTAL CREDITS FOR GRADUATION: (Cohorts 2013-2014)</b>		<b>25 CREDITS</b>
<b>(Cohorts 2015-forward)</b>		<b>24 CREDITS</b>
<b><i>From the "total credits" the following must be included:</i></b>		
<b>ENGLISH</b>		<b>4 CREDITS</b>
<b>MATH</b>		<b>4 CREDITS</b>
<i>Beginning with class (cohort) 2013, 4 math credits are required: Courses shall consist of Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2 (or an equivalent to Algebra 2) in order to graduate.</i>		
<b>SCIENCE</b>		<b>3 CREDITS</b>
<i>2 CREDITS OF Agriculture Science satisfy 1 science credit towards RVHS graduation requirements and also meets 1 lab science for entrance to ASU, U of A, and NAU or any other out of state 4-year university.</i>		
<b>WORLD HISTORY</b>		<b>1 CREDIT</b>
<i>(Sophomore Year required class, but can be taken during Freshman year if schedule allows it)</i>		
<b>AMERICAN HISTORY</b>		<b>1 CREDIT</b>
<i>(Junior Year required class)</i>		
<b>CIVICS- .5 AMERICAN GOVERNMENT, .5 ECONOMICS</b>		<b>1 CREDIT</b>
<i>(Senior Year required class)</i>		
<b>PHYSICAL EDUCATION (RVHS REQUIREMENT)</b>		<b>1 CREDIT</b>
<b>FINE ARTS OR CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION COURSE</b>		<b>1 CREDIT</b>
<i>If the CTE course is counted for this credit, it must be a 2<sup>nd</sup> level course, not an entry level course. Also, this course can only be used in this category and not as the Sophomore Required CTE credit.</i>		
<b>FRESHMAN CAREER PREP</b>		<b>1 CREDIT</b>
<i>This is an entry level course called "Career Prep" that is required by all freshmen at RVHS or can be a beginning course in a CTE program.</i>		
<b>SOPHOMORE REQUIRED CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION COURSE (Cohort 2016 forward)</b>		<b>1 CREDIT</b>
<i>This can be an entry level or 2<sup>nd</sup> level CTE course.</i>		
<b>ELECTIVE COURSES</b>		<b>6,7, OR 8 CREDITS</b>
<i>This number depends on your cohort group and your math and/or total credits needed.</i>		

**2<sup>nd</sup> Level "CTE" Career Preparation** will be considered courses which include Transportation Systems, Automotive Technology, Applied Biological Systems, Agriculture Business Management, Cabinet Making 1-3, Business Management 2-3, Desktop Publishing 2 (Yearbook), and Welding 2-3. Off campus NAVIT programs may also meet this requirement.

**"Sophomore Required" CTE Course** list includes: Business & Tech Communications, Business & Personal Applications, Construction & Manufacturing, Beginning Auto, Beginning Agricultural Science, Welding 1, and Desktop Publishing 1.

**Fine Arts** will include Sculpture & Ceramics, Drawing and Painting, Chorale, Madrigal Choir, Men's Choir, Women's Choir, Band, Guitar, Theater/Drama, or Technical Theater.
