Application deadline: received by 5 p.m. Friday, March 16, 2018

Scholarship Award Amount: One (1) Scholarship will be awarded at \$2,000, **nonrenewable**.

To be eligible for the scholarship, an applicant must:

1. Be a graduating high school senior, who is an Arizona resident
2. Have a minimum 3.50 GPA (non-weighted)
3. Reside within the geographic area of Arizona White Mountains (Heber/Overgaard, Pinetop-Lakeside, Snowflake/Taylor, St. Johns, Springerville, Show Low, Whiteriver)
4. Achieve a minimum ACT score of 24 combined and/or SAT score of 1100 combined
5. Be admitted to Arizona State for the fall 2018 semester
6. Not participate in Intercollegiate Athletics as an ASU student athlete while attending ASU
7. Awards may not be deferred for illness or religious reasons. The posting of award funds each semester will be conditional based on the receipt of current semester transcripts by post or e-mail to the scholarship committee.
8. All scholarship recipients are required to attend the annual White Mountain Steak Fry in Pinetop on June 2, 2018 and participate in the two-day event in some capacity.

Note regarding eligibility:

***Applications will not be accepted/considered for students participating in or receiving scholarships with ASU Intercollegiate Athletics as an ASU student athlete while attending ASU, or their immediate family members.**

****To ensure this award's maximum benefit is received, students who are granted more comprehensive awards may not be granted these funds and a new recipient may be selected.**

Application Procedure

All documents should be type-written, with the applicant's name appearing on each document.

Please submit **5 copies of all documents provided in addition to the original. Applications will not be considered or read unless all 5 copies are received.**

1. Completed scholarship application
2. A type-written statement (maximum 1 page, double-spaced) describing personal & family background, goals for higher education and career goals
3. Copy of your high school transcript (unofficial copies are acceptable) include current class schedule, AIMS scores, ACT/SAT scores, GPA, class rank
4. 2 letters of recommendation, on letterhead, from persons who can attest to potential academic success and character of applicant
